

Little Miss Lindon Parents Information Sheet

Welcome to the Little Miss Lindon Program. We are happy that you have decided to be a part of this wonderful year of service! We know you will have a great experience. Here are a few things you will need to know and understand to try out for Little Miss Lindon.

Entry fee is \$30.00 and must accompany the return of your application. Deadline for the application is Friday, January 16th 2026. Please return application to the Lindon Community Center located at 25 N. Main St. We fill up fast-and can only take 20 applicants. It is on a first come first served basis. Once you return your application and pay your fee you will receive our Orientation Tea invite. You can also find the application at www.lindonrecreation.org

There will be a mandatory Orientation Tea for all contestants and a responsible adult, at Lindon Community Center on Saturday, January 24th from 10:00 am until 12:00 noon. The girls will have their pictures taken for the judge's packets, choose their contestant numbers and receive instructions regarding the pageant and workshops and events throughout the year.

There will also be 3 mandatory workshops. These will be held on Friday, January 30th Friday, February 6th and Friday, February 20th from 4 to 7 pm and you will learn more about these workshops at the tea.

Please decide on your talent as quickly as possible. There will be NO DUPLICATIONS of songs. Talent time is 1 minute 30 seconds and this is strictly enforced. No live accompanist can be used.

Each contestant is required to do a service project. It does not need to be huge! It should be something that would be meaningful to the contestant. The contestant will need to make a poster (24X36) of her service project to display for the judges to view, so take lots of pictures! **Our group service project will be Saturday February 7th.**

The pageant will be held on Saturday, February 28th 2026 in the Oak Canyon Junior High School auditorium. It will begin at 6 pm. There is a mandatory dress rehearsal at Oak Canyon Junior High on Friday, February 27th 2026, starting at 3:45 pm sharp.

Guidelines:

1. All contestants must be residents of Lindon City, Pleasant Grove, Orem or attend a Lindon school.
2. Contestants must be in 5th, 6th, or 7th grade the year the pageant is held.
3. Parents are expected to work closely with the Pageant Director and city by volunteering and working with the Royalty and other parents. Parents or guardians of Royalty members are responsible to build the float and be on the pageant committee for the next year. Parents of the Little Miss Lindon Royalty must pass a background check in order to participate and volunteer. If any parent cannot pass a background check, a responsible adult must be recommended to fulfill the parent's duties.
4. All members of the Little Miss Lindon Royalty MUST be willing to represent the city in the following parades:
 - Cedar Hills- Saturday June 6, 2026 (morning)
 - Orem City Summer Fest- Saturday June 6, 2026(evening)
 - Springville Art City Days- Saturday June 13, 2026
 - Strawberry Days-Saturday June 20, 2026
 - Provo Freedom Festival- Saturday July 4, 2026
 - Spanish Fork Fiesta Days- Friday July 24, 2026
 - Lindon Days- July 27 - August 1, 2026
5. All members of the royalty will be required to participate in all parades, service dates and Lindon Days activities.
