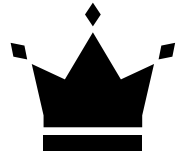


# 2023 Lindon Days Junior Rodeo Royalty Competition



April 29th at 9:00am – Contestants should be checked in by 8:45am

Open to young ladies 12-17 years old in Utah County

The pageant will be held at the Lindon City Community Center 25 N Main Street Lindon,  
UT 84042

Horsemanship will be held at the Lindon Rodeo arena just south of the community center.

The competition will include:

- Modeling of Western Attire
- Prepared Speech
- Impromptu Questions
- Personal Interview
- Horsemanship



Speeches can be written on a topic of choice, but should somehow relate to the horses, rodeo, or western way of life.

Western attire should include a western cowboy hat, cowboy boots, a belt, long pants, and a long sleeve western shirt. A formal Rodeo Queen western dress may be worn for the indoor portion of the competition but is not required.

**Expectations:**

The Royalty will be asked to participate in neighboring city's parades and grand entry at their rodeos, especially in the Strawberry Days and Lehi Round-up Celebrations. Please note that some PRCA rodeos do not allow anyone under the age of 16 into the arena. Some rodeos will allow those under 16 to ride for one night of the rodeo, some may not allow those who are under 16 to ride in any night of the rodeo, and some allow any age to come all nights. If any members of the royalty are 16 or older, they may participate. There are many other rodeos that are not PRCA which will allow for younger girls to ride in their grand entry.

All member of the royalty are required to attend the Lindon Days City Celebration July 29<sup>th</sup> – August 5<sup>th</sup>. This includes but is not limited to the parade and Junior Rodeo. The royalty oversees hosting the Cowgirl Clinic July 31st and the Lindon City Trail Ride July 29<sup>th</sup>. They will also be expected to help host the Lindon Playday Horse Show in July.

# Lindon Days Rodeo Royalty Pageant Application Agreement and Waiver

## General Rules:

- Contestant must be between the ages of 12 and 17 at the time of competition.
- Contestant lives in Utah County.
- Contestant must not have been a previous Lindon Junior Rodeo Queen.
- Contestant must provide their own horse and transportation for the horsemanship portion of the pageant as well as for the rodeo and all events.
- Contestant understands that they are a representative of both Lindon City and the sport of rodeo and will be expected to conduct themselves in a way that is consistent with their title in their lives as well as on social media. Drama and inappropriate behavior of any kind at the contest, online, or at any event will not be tolerated and may result in loss of title. The crown and sash would then be passed down to the next young woman.
- Each member of the royalty will have certain appearances that they are expected to be at. These were stated on the application and may be subject to change.
- Contestant must understand that they will only be able to participate in grand entry for some PRCA rodeos if they are 16 years of age or older. If one or more members of the royalty are under 16, and another is over 16, the young lady who is 16 or 17 may still ride in the rodeos to promote Lindon Days.
- Contestants and parental guardians understand that rodeo and horseback riding does present a risk of physical injury. Lindon city and the Lindon Days Rodeo Committee are not responsible for any injuries that may occur during the contestant's reign or during the competition.
- Contestant and families understand that all decisions made by the judges are final.

**By signing you verify that you have read and are willing to comply with each rule and are stating that you assume the risk of all injury sustained to her person. You are also agreeing to conduct yourself in an honorable manner throughout your reign and understand that failure to do so may result in loss of title.**
