When the paperwork came back from Washington D.C., the spelling had a small error, but the residents decided to just let “Lindon” stick. Historical accounts say that community gatherings or celebrations were held sporadically, but it wasn’t until 1940 when Alroy Gilman (born in 1901 in Lindon) presented an official proposal for a community fair to be held annually. Thus, “Lindon Days” was born.
